2. Transition planning around the state	Brief discussion about expanding transition clinic services to other areas of the state. Dr. Wood will be talking to CMS about seed money that would be necessary in order to start and staff transition clinics in other areas of the state such as Orlando and Miami. 3. Strategic Issue #3	Dr. Wood has meeting planned with Representative Cummings in Clay County on Dec. 30, 2013. We will invite other patients, including CMS or former CMS patients, to attend the meeting to try to get support for a special appropriation for \$500,000 to expand and enhance transitional services in our area. These services would be piloted, evaluated, and if successful and we can demonstrate value, then it can be replicated across the state. There is Senate support from Senator Aaron Bean, not just needing House support. 4. Strategic Issue #1	We will increase outreach and promotion through additional banners and promotional materials distributed and displayed throughout area clinics and hospitals. We will also initiate an email campaign to local pediatric offices to offer a lunch and learn about JacksonvilleHATS coalition and JaxHATS transitional services. We will focus on large practices with several CMS patients.
