





Terry Eason asked, "What the goal is?" Rita replied that is focus on overall quality improvement for our services to the patients and their families. It will help with closing the gap of provider and patient care. We want our patients to give us input on service or what we could do better. Dr. Nathawad also mentioned that we want to offer support to the patients regarding their medical diagnoses. Would it be better to group them by dx to discuss issues to allow them to express their feelings with their peers, also having a capable professional- volunteer to facilitate the meetings. Dr. Nathawad suggested maybe mirroring the Delores Weaver Mental Health Youth Council, where the youth run the meetings and discuss issues that need to be addressed. Terry Eason gave an overview of Community Hospice/ Peds Care Youth Council. The group meets quarterly for a fun event. Social workers are present at the planning meetings and events. She says they have a good turnout. Carol Fulton asked, in our population what will keep the group coming consistently? She proposed food and maybe feeling connected with the other youth may help. Audrey mentioned that working with JaxHATS in past experiences most will say they come and then no show to the event. The efforts sometimes seem to be on JaxHATS and not with the patients. Terry suggested maybe offer to eligible sibling of patients and patients as community service hours for school. Anne asked, what is the ultimate outcome? Dr. Nathawad stated, a voice, their voice needs to be heard. Sherry Buchman express that we have two distinct groups within JaxHATS, those with intellectual/behavioral disabilities and those that are dealing with chronic medical conditions, which could cause a major issue when meeting because these are very different. There would need to be two separates groups because one group may not be able to handle the other.

- **Building a stronger bridge to connect pediatric and adult providers**
  1. Consult services with JaxHATS and the pediatric community before transfer of care. Engage the patient, parents and pediatrician with the services of our transition clinic. Dr. Nathawad stated that the plan is to get out into the pediatric community more to discuss networking.
  
- **Engaging special populations into transition services (Foster Care, Juvenile Justice, PACE, JASMYN)**
  1. Dr. Rita has reached out to these populations and have collaborative progress plans in motion with Juvenile Justice and JASMYN.
