It will take additional meetings and discussions to support need and make a case for transition <p>Asked the group about needs in transition, the following needs were discussed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Social work and coordination services in other specialty clinics Additional psychiatric care and assistance You taking ownership/coming to terms with disease Assessing maturity and emotional level of family and youth Groups for support, peer-to-peer, advocates, parent-parent Suggestion that Psych residents take leadership role in meeting community need to address these concerns Suggestion to reach out to other local universities and tap into their educational programs for support group facilitation and other assistance. It was suggested that we invite a lawyer, attorney, or Florida Coastal Law school student to be a part of this coalition. 4. DOH Budget	Dr. Wood is asking for \$500,000 as a line item in the DOH for assistance to expand JaxHATS services as a regional program. If approved, it would be complimentary to the Wolfson proposal. Dr. Wood would like to hear comments and change requests prior to submission.
