Following introductions, Ms. Stannard, Dr. Rosa-Olivares, and Dr. Hess reviewed the Florida Title V Needs Assessment process and Transition Action Plan (see attached PPT). Subsequent discussion items included:

- Ms. Stannard clarified that the approved plan will be submitted to MCHB by the end of June. She also explained that transition financing and policy goals/objectives were not included in the plan because CMSN cannot fully control factors associated with meeting those types of objectives.
- Ms. Redmon recommended that we conduct a study of former CMSN enrollees who have aged out of services, to get a better understanding of their experiences, challenges, and successes in transitioning to adult health care.
- There was some discussion about the MOA between CMSN and the Florida Association of Community Health Centers. A new MOA has been drafted and forwarded to Andy Behrman (FACHC) for review, though he has not yet responded. Ideally, the PanhandleHATS CMSN/FQHC navigation model can be replicated within other Florida communities. Ms. Rockwell said that an important component in that model is the linkage between CMSN and FQHC social workers in driving the transfer of care process.
