Following introductions, these items were discussed:

1. Dr. McCormick outlined a transitional care curriculum he is developing for the USF Med-Peds Residency program as part of a fellowship project, see www.floridahats.org/wp-content/uploads/2011/01/McCormick_Adult_Modules_11-3-11.pdf. An online component of the curriculum will be a series of short (10-20 minutes) standardized modules that focus on adult-oriented ambulatory care of patients with selected childhood onset diseases/conditions (e.g., Down Syndrome). Module content will also focus on cross-cutting issues such adolescent brain development, disability etiquette, alternative communication methods, etc. Dr. Woodard suggested the modules also incorporate patient perspectives. Dr. McCormick is concurrently exploring MOC requirements for Internal Medicine.

Dr. McCormick views this as an opportunity to collaborate with other MAC members, and welcomes participation from anyone who would like to contribute to content development.
